Project Description:

Uganda Youth Skills Training Organization (UYSTO) is a legally and dully registered Non-Governmental Organization, with the aim of availing and empowering children, youth and women in Uganda with social and economic sustainable development

Work: a) Expertise in any of the following: Music, Dance and Drama. b) Planning monitoring and evaluation of the students in any of the subjects above. (a) c) Training/instructing and teaching in any of the subjects above in (a). d) Career guidance and basic counselling to the students

Requirements: a) Being in position to socialize, open minded and flexible b) Good communication c) At least with basic knowledge in any of the requested subjects above. d) Able to network freely. e) Innovative and creative. f) Averagely multicultural compliant

Food: Volunteers prepare their own food. UPA provides gas cooker, a fridge, and utensils. Alternatively, a volunteer can stay with a host family to be more

exposed to the Ugandan culture

Accommodation: Volunteers has the possibility to choose between staying in the guesthouse, with different international volunteers (sharing room, normally 2-4 people) or to stay in a host family. Accommodation is at the UPA Guesthouse, average but not luxury

Pocket money: None

Insurance: The volunteer is required to come with his/her insurance

Fees: 500 EUR one time payment. The fee covers pickup from the airport or bus station upon arrival in Uganda, orientation, guesthouse maintenance, and administration costs of UPA

Visa: Volunteers must apply for a tourist visa online with this link. <https://www.visas.immigration.g>. This should be done a couple of weeks or months before the departure date. Please refer to infosheet

Others: 500 Euros shall be paid on arrival for one to three months .If the volunteer is to stay for more than 3 months, 80 euros are paid per extra month in advance
